LWV Minnesota Suffrage Day Suffrage Memorial Garden Minnesota State Capitol, St. Paul, MN</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Sunday, September 29, 2019 3:00—5:00 pm LWV St. Cloud Area Centennial Kick-off Event Stearns History Museum, St. Cloud, MN</p> <p>The St. Cloud Area League of Women Voters will co-sponsor, with the Stearns History Museum, a celebration commemorating Minnesota ratifying the 19th Amendment on September 8, 1919. Formation of the Minnesota League of Women Voters occurred shortly thereafter, on October 19, 1919.</p> <p>This event will feature a keynote speaker and refreshments and is free and open to the public.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">October 26, 2019 LWV Minnesota Sponsored Centennial Gala Union Depot, St. Paul, MN</p>	<p>March, 1919 Minnesota Legislature grants women in the state the right to vote for presidential electors.</p> <p>June, 2019 US Congress approves a 19th Amendment to be ratified by three fourths of the States.</p> <p>September 8, 1919 Minnesota becomes the 15th state to ratify the 19th Amendment.</p> <p>October 29, 1919 Minnesota Suffrage League disbands and forms Minnesota League of Women Voters.</p> <p>February 14, 1920 National League of Women Voters established.</p> <p>August 18, 1920 Tennessee becomes the 36th state to ratify the 19th Amendment.</p> <p>August 26, 1920 19th Amendment certified and added to the US Constitution.</p>

19th Amendment to the US Constitution

The right of citizens of the United States to vote shall not be denied or abridged by the United States or by any State on account of sex.

Congress shall have power to enforce this article by appropriate legislation.
